UPVC/PVCU

The use of UPVC for catteries has increased significantly over the past five years. The reasons for this are:

- Well-known and familiar product for replacement doors and windows that is quick and easy to assemble
- Easy to clean and non-porous
- Professional and clean appearance
- Is generally supplied in a white finish. Alternative colour options are available, but are more expensive (these are only used on the external face with white still being used internally).
- The product may expand slightly during periods of **prolonged heat**. Although this can be an irritation if doors/ windows temporarily do not close smoothly, it does settle down again when the temperature cools

What to check:

- Check on the manufacturers warranty for discolouration most offer a 10 year warranty for yellowing
- Costs are similar to better quality timber equivalents, or can vary up to 20% compared with poorer quality timber
- There are large variations in cost/quality between manufacturers, for what at first appear to be the same product!
- Careful consideration of the manufacturer's specification is essential to establish what the differences are to compare like-for-like. For example: compared with 25mm/1" polycarbonate opal/bronze-tinted roof sheeting, the heat-shield coating option can double the cost. This isn't noticeable when you see the products, but on a hot day you would certainly feel the difference in temperature!
- Can look more obtrusive when used as a stand-alone building in certain settings, (landscaping obviously helps any building 'settle in') but looks extremely smart in a traditional construction, or in a building conversion

The quality of the material varies **enormously** between manufacturers

Any concern about the use of this product with regard to possible extremes of temperature and ventilation issues is probably associated with poor design, poor quality roofing materials and also a possible over-use of glass.

Next we will learn more about using UPVC cat pens, followed by a case study of a rescue cattery using UPVC:

This rescue charity constructed two full-sized catteries using UPVC in the UK's hot south west and had no issues. The site in question is set in an old quarry with 30 ft/10 m cliffs on two sides. Consequently, the centre does experience extremely high temperatures, often over prolonged periods of time. It is interesting that the UPVC catteries replaced an old timber cattery. With the timber unit there were considerable problems with extremes in hot weather, with temperatures well in excess of 30°C/86°F. Even with the installation of additional insulation on the roof, the centre still had to run cooling fans during the summer months and hang blankets etc over the exercise runs. With the UPVC cattery, the centre staff do not have any concerns about heat issues or ventilation and are extremely pleased with the quality of the product.

CONVERSION


